TENTATIVE ITINERARY

APRIL 28 - FRIDAY, DAY 1

- ★ Depart from your group's pickup location for Norfolk, VA making rest stops and a lunch stop on your own along the way.
- ★ Arrive in Norfolk, VA and visit the **NORFOLK BOTANICAL GARDENS**. Visit by **TRAM** the 155-acre garden of one of the largest collections of azaleas, camellias, and rhododendrons on the East Coast.
- ★ Check in to your Virginia Beach, VA hotel.
- ★ Tonight **DINNER IS INCLUDED** in an area restaurant.

APRIL 29 - SATURDAY, DAY 2

- ★ Enjoy lunch on your own at the NATO Fest from the many international offerings.
- ★ This afternoon we tour the **NAUTICUS NATIONAL MARITIME CENTER**, an exciting science and technology center exploring the power of the sea.
- ★ Visit the **BATTLESHIP USS WISCONSIN**, one of the largest Battleships ever built. This mighty ship was used during the Korean Conflict, the Vietnam War and the Gulf War.
- ★ This afternoon we'll make a stop at **DOUMAR'S**, home of the world's first ice cream cone machine. Abe Doumar created the first ice cream cone at the World's Fair in 1904 in St. Louis. We'll listen to an introduction to the cone machine and everyone will be treated to an ice cream and cone.
- ★ Stop at the **DOUGLAS MACARTHUR MEMORIAL** for a glimpse into our country's history. View the outstanding collection housed in Norfolk's historic city hall which traces the life and achievements of five-star General Douglas MacArthur.
- ★ **DINNER IS INCLUDED** at an area restaurant before we head out for evening entertainment.
- ★ Tonight we're treated to the evening performance of the **VIRGINIA INTERNATIONAL TATTOO WITH RESERVED PREMIUM SEATING**. It's a true spectacle of military splendor - part parade, part theater and sometimes, part circus. The Tattoo features bands and forms of drill display, regimental bands, drums and pipes, massed bugle ensembles and fireworks to delight all ages!

APRIL 30 - SUNDAY, DAY 3

- ★ Enjoy the **DELUXE CONTINENTAL BREAKFAST** at our hotel.
- ★ This morning we start with a tour of the **NORFOLK NAVAL STATION**. This is homeport to more than 80 ships of the Atlantic Fleet and the world's largest naval installation.
- ★ Lunch will be on your own today in the **MACARTHUR CENTER**. You'll find everything from sit-down fine dining to a food court with many quick and inexpensive options as well as lots of great shopping!
- ★ This afternoon we'll depart on a **NARRATED NORFOLK HARBOR CRUISE**. We'll hear fascinating and entertaining commentary during the two-hour excursion aboard a naval themed vessel.
- ★ Tonight we'll head over to the **VIRGINIA BEACH MILITARY AVIATION MUSEUM**. The Military Aviation Museum is home to one of the largest private collections of World War I and World War II era military aircraft in the world. Each piece has been beautifully restored to its prior military condition, using original parts whenever possible. Most of the planes are airworthy and flown at the museum during flight demonstrations and at air shows throughout the year. Tonight we'll also enjoy a **CATERED BRISKET & BBQ CHICKEN BUFFET DINNER** along with a very interesting talk with "**ROSIE THE RIVETER**".

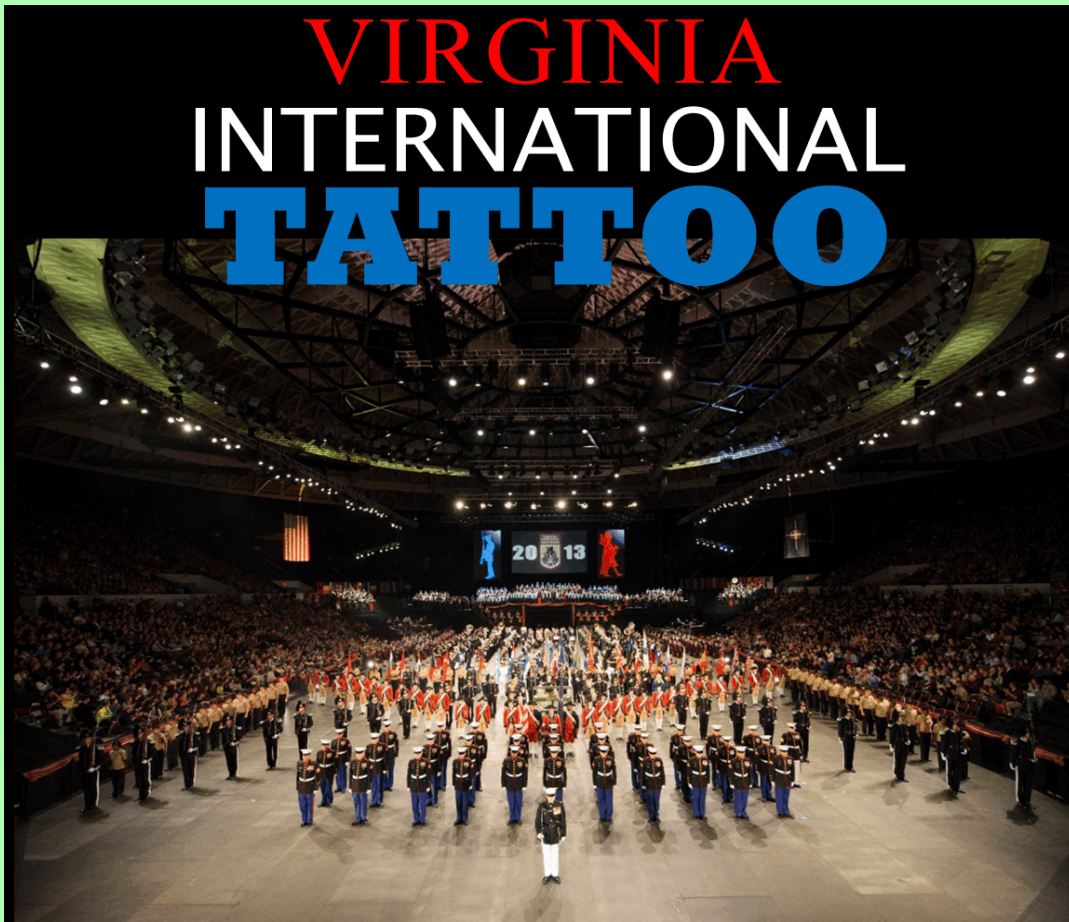
MAY 1 - MONDAY, DAY 4
